WHITE WINES

The Fathoms Sauvignon Blanc Glass £6.50/ Bottle £22

Marlborough, New Zealand — Typical of a Kiwi Sauvignon, the bouquet springs from the glass, offering plumes of citrus, green grass and elderflower. The palate is a burst of crisp grapefruit and gooseberry flavours.

El Cante Albariño Bottle £25

Ías Baixas, Spain — Galicia's signature white wine from the region's most famous producer. A light, fresh and youthful wine with a zesty and well defined citrus backbone, overlaid with subtle hints of stone fruits and nectar. Crisp and refreshing, yet rounded and enduring on the finish.

Saint-Véran 'Les Deux Moulins' Bottle £30

Maison Louis Latour — Although less famous than its neighbour Pouilly-Fuissé, the two are similar in terms of relief, production techniques and even their actual taste/fragrance. Charming floral aromas laced with honeysuckle and on the palate round with lovely sappiness, lifted by softer muscat-like hints.

Sancerre Blanc, Berthier Bottle £37

Loire Valley, France — Aromas of grapefruit, gooseberry and hints of lime. The palate is elegant with a mineral texture, high acidity, vibrant green fruits and a long finish

ROSÉ WINES

Sancerre, Pinot Rosé, Lucien Crochet Bottle £28

Loire Valley, France — Intense Pinot fruit comes to the fore here with notes of raspberry, strawberry and minerals.

RED WINES

Aires Andinos Malbec Glass £7.50 Bottle £21.50

Mendoza, Argentina — Deep ruby coloured with smoky black fruits of cassis, blackberry and spice. The concentration of this wine performs well above its price point with soft tannins and a long finish.

Oltre Passo Primitivo, IGT Bottle £24.50

Salento, Italy — Deep and dense in colour with a nose of warm prunes, dates and figs and hints of sweet spice. The palate is full, yet soft and plush with toasty notes that linger on the finish.

Rioja Selection Especial Reserva Bottle £38

Muga Rioja, Spain — An enticing and complex nose of pain grillé and blackberry leads into an elegant wine with layers of flavour, fruit and sweet spice with ripe and integrated tannins and a lengthy finish.

Châteauneuf-du-Pape, Clos de L'Oratoire des Papes Bottle £45

Rhône Valley, France — An intense, perfumed and enticing array of sweet spices, brooding black fruits and sweet red cherries. Earthy, fruity, spicy and complex layers of flavour are marshalled by firm tannins into a long finish
