STARTERS (please choose one)

Salad of confit 'Heritage' carrots, soft goats curd, peppery leaves with an orange and olive oil emulsion

Chilled watercress soup with cornish crab and poached quail's egg

Seared scallops with poached english asparagus and Sauterne butter (subject to availability)

Prawn, Hass avocado, heritage tomato and baby basil thermidor

Duck liver parfait, Muscat oranges, baby watercress salad and toasted brioche

Gressingham duck and salad, shaved cauliflower, peppery leaves and citrus dressing

MAINS (please choose one)

Poached native lobster with champagne Sabayon and baby summer vegetables

Parma wrapped monkfish loin with a grape tomato and fresh chilli salad, wilted baby pousse and pomme purée

Organic chicken breast with an english asparagus, pea, broad bean and summer truffle risotto

Roast guinea fowl breast, white onion and sage risotto cake, charred tenderstem broccoli and madeira jus

Rack of grass-fed lamb with summer peas, broad beans, Jersey Royals and a light jus

Seared Aberdeen Angus beef fillet with roasted new season's potatoes, confit shallots, Forsyth's english fine green beans and classic Béarnaise

DESSERT (please choose one)

Elderflower cheesecake with candied citrus fruits and a wafer thin caramel biscuit

Warm date cake with semi-dried pears, toffee ice cream and a pear crisp

Vanilla panna cotta, rice pudding mousse, crumble and textures of rhubarb

Strawberry jelly with passion fruit and banana sorbet, classic shortbread and dried strawberries

Chocolate and brown butter ganache, english raspberries and sorbet quenelle

Tiramisu mousse with almond biscuit and a caramelised white chocolate tuille
